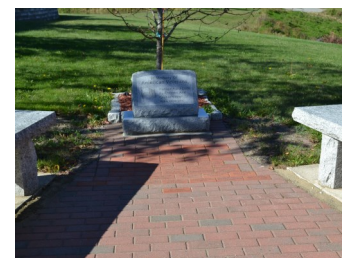
2015 Totally Trades—huge success!
