

## Coastal Fisheries and Marine Technology Instructor

Full-time, Grant funded

**General Position Information:** WCCC is seeking to fill a full-time a grant funded Coastal Fisheries and Marine Technology faculty position. This position is responsible for oversight of curriculum creation and revision; classroom instruction; collaborate with department chair and management on course scheduling; student academic advising and student recruitment; management of program standards and assessment of program outcomes; establish and maintain collaborative relationships with colleges and universities and establish and preserve external stakeholder relationships. This position instructs 15 credit hours per semester, is on a day/evening schedule and teaches in both traditional and distance education (including online) as well as off-campus settings.

Qualifications: Multi-faceted experience with Maine's working waterfronts and both capture and culture fisheries. Broad knowledge and experience in marine technology topics including marine engine, electrical, water, and hydraulic systems and highly proficient in vessel operations and marine safety. Teaching experience is preferred, including effective presentation skills. The ideal individual would be well connected within the fishing community and have experience in both conservation efforts and industry advocacy. Proof of up-to-date Covid-19 vaccination required prior to the first day of employment, subject to exemptions recognized by law.
