1. 11 in 1 screwdriver
2. Insulated Philips and flathead screwdriver
3. Clamp-on electrical meter
4. Standard wrenches sizes 1/4 to 3/4
5. Metric wrenches sizes 6mm to 14mm
6. Standard nut drivers
7. Metric nut drivers
8. Diagonal cutters
9. Wire strippers
10. Adjustable wrenches 8" and 12"
11. Locking pump pliers
12. 12" speed level
13. Tape measure
14. Copper tubing cutter (ensure it does up to 1 1/4")
15. Tubing reamer
16. Utility knife
