- Set of 8 allen type hex key wrenches 0.50" to 1/4"-6" long
- Copper tube hand-flaring tool
- Klein CL210 clamp meeter
- Ball peen hammer, 8 oz.
- Electricians cutting pliers
- Pliers, 12" arc joint (water pump pliers)
- Solder flux
- Leather work boots
- Flashlight – mini maglite
- Cable stripper
- Long-nose pliers
