New! Virtual Study Hall

What: Daily Study Hall for all WCCC Students

We realize that students need help throughout the week with a variety of questions and concerns, and many students do not have the opportunity to drop into TRIO SSS. The Virtual Study Hall is open to all students. Simply log on at noon, M-F and a TRIO staff member will be available to help you. Each session is live on Zoom, just login.

Why:



<u>Traditional School Supplies</u>: Much of your work will be completed on the computer, but you will need items such as pens, pencils, highlighters, binders, and notebook paper on hand. Depending on the course, you may still need to purchase textbooks and other required items.

<u>Pens, Pencils, and Highlighters</u>: Classes may require heavy notetaking so students should have plenty of pens and pencils on hand.

<u>Paper and Notebooks</u>: Online learning requires a lot of paper. Math classes take plenty of writing and scratch paper. We recommend that students dedicate a notebook to each subject for the purpose of taking notes.

Folders, Files, or Binders: It is always good to have notes organized for each class so they are readily available for completion of assignments and tests.

<u>Planner for the Academic Year</u>: Use the free WCCC planner for the academic year or use an online site to create a daily schedule.

Bookbag: A backpack with room for a laptop, books and other supplies will be useful when you move to another location.

<u>Flash Drive</u>: A flash drive is a way to provide storage that can be accessed from any computer. Backing up important assignments on a flash drive is a good idea.

Earphones, Earbuds, Noise Canceling Headphones:
A set of earphones or earbuds will help ensure you do not disturb those around you and can also drown out outside noise to minimize distractions. *TRIO notes* * →

Reliable Computer and Internet Access: It is essential for students to have a reliable computer that operates at a good speed and is able to handle a variety of different programs. Your internet should also be reasonably fast and reliable. It is a good idea to have a backup option for online work if your primary connection is having issues.

<u>Webcam</u>: Online classes and tutoring frequently use Zoom or a similar program to enable virtual class attendance. If your device is not already equipped with a camera, you will want to obtain a webcam.

<u>Printer</u>: A printer is helpful but typically not necessary to complete work for your online courses. The *TRIO Study Center* has printers for student use on campus.

Necessary Software: The software needed for online learning will probably be covered by Microsoft Office 365. *Microsoft offers its Office 365 subscription plan free to students*. Visit the Microsoft website and search for the Office 365 Education web page.

<u>Dedicated Workspace</u>: If possible, a dedicated workspace can provide a quiet and comfortable space that is essential to be able to accomplish your work.

The *TRIO Study Center* has three computer stations with internet connection, webcam, and handphones* available by appointment if you need a dedicated workspace. Students may print in TRIO.

TRIO can provide most traditional school supplies listed above and flash drives to TRIO members. TRIO members who meet specific criteria can qualify for free noise canceling headphones.*


