**W**, Approved Withdrawal, may be issued after the add/drop period and up the end of the 10<sup>th</sup> week in a 15- or 16-week course, the 5<sup>th</sup> week in an 8-week course and the 4<sup>th</sup> week in a 6- or 7- week course. After that, a student may request a “Special Circumstance” by submitting a request in writing to the Academic Dean or the Dean of Students, which may result in a W designation, if approved. Course withdrawal will be recorded as a “W” on the student’s transcript but will not be computed in the grade point average. A “W” is considered an attempted course for the purpose of satisfactory academic progress. This is a student and/or administration-initiated grade designation.
